Year 5—Friday 9th December, 1.30 - 3.00 pm

Year 5 will be learning about the Bayeux Tapestry as part of the Curriculum Week - Anglo-Saxons. We will be examining the events of the period using ICT (Imagination Room) leading to the recreation of our own version using the laptops.

Year 4—Thursday 8th December— 9.30 am.—12.00

There will be three simultaneous lessons based on our year 4 topic: **Ancient Egypt**. We will be in the Imagination Studio taking a 3D virtual tour of the pyramids to set the scene for our story telling. In classrooms, we will be digitally decoding hidden messages in Egyptian hieroglyphs and also putting our research and design planning together to make our money containers for the tourists of Egypt.

As we continue our preparations for Christmas, we will be learning about how Christmas is celebrated in different countries within Europe. There will also be an opportunity for you to look at your child's books if you wish to.

Year 3—Thursday 8th December—1.30 - 3.00 pm

This half term in Year 3, we have been learning about the Stone Age. On our curriculum day, we are going to be reconstructing Stonehenge with biscuits! Our plan is to first of all explore Stonehenge and find out when it was built and what it actually is. We are very excited to become explorers of the Stone Age.
