BOREATTON PARK RESIDENTIAL WEEKEND

Dear Parent/ Carer,

RE: Boreatton Park Residential Weekend

As we are due to leave on Friday, I wanted to provide you all with some final information regarding our weekend away.

There will be a daily update on Twitter, which can be seen on the school website, of what we have been doing, as well as an update on what time we expect to be arriving back to school on the Sunday evening. Should you have any emergency where you need to contact us, please phone the site itself. The number is 01939260551. This number is only to be used if you have an emergency and need to get in touch with us. If for any reason we need to be in contact with you, we will inform Miss Blackmore who will ring you directly.

Children are not allowed to bring any sweets or snacks, as these will be provided throughout the weekend by the centre and ourselves. Children are also not allowed any electrical devices, including mobile phones and cameras. If children do bring these, they will be kept securely with a member of staff until we return from the trip.

Children can wear their own clothes to school on Friday but please ensure that your child has everything with them ready to leave, unless you are able to see us off at 2pm. Please also ensure that children only bring the essentials and a few changes of clothes in a small bag.

There is a small gift shop that will be open before we leave on the Sunday, so if you would like, your child can bring a maximum of £5 with them to spend. This money will be collected in by staff and will be kept safe until it is needed.

Activities that have been confirmed for the weekend include: Jacobs ladder, trapeze, archery, orienteering, giant swing, and kayaking. During water based activities, all children will wear life jackets. If you do not wish for your child to join in with any of the activities, then please let your child's class teacher know.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please send them to school with their medication, and enough for them to take on the return journey.
