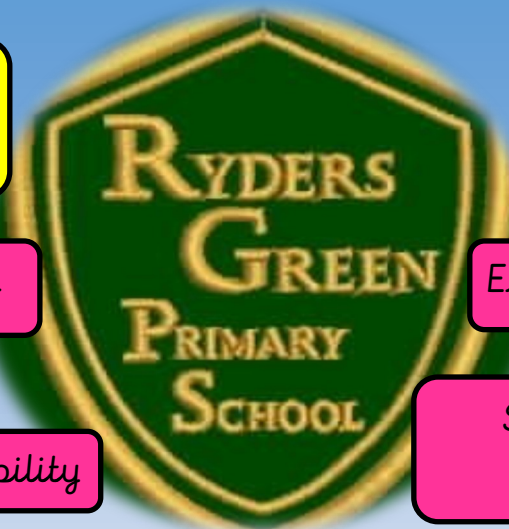

 - Children should be actively using Bug Club, TTRockstars and Spelling Shed to support their learning.

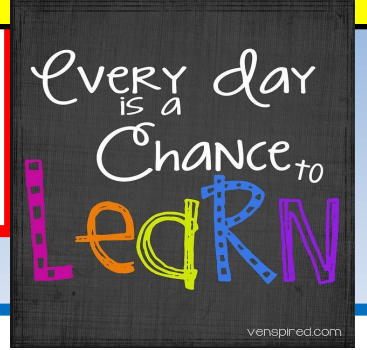

- Learn to play the trumpet.

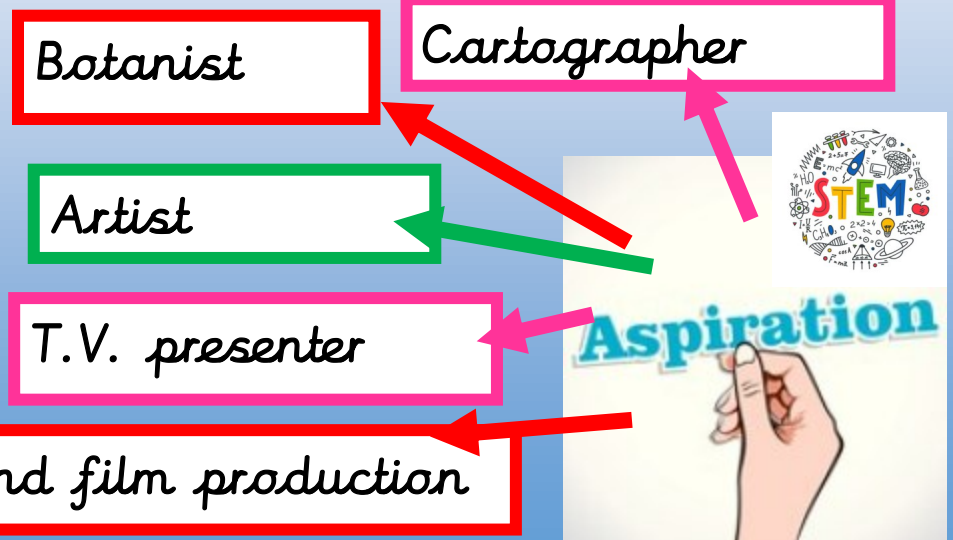
- In Geography we will:**
