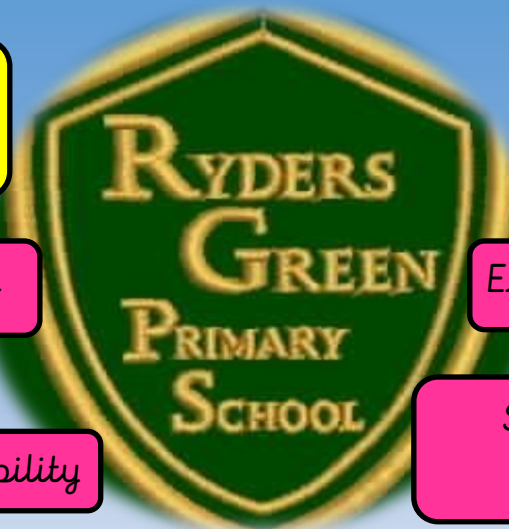

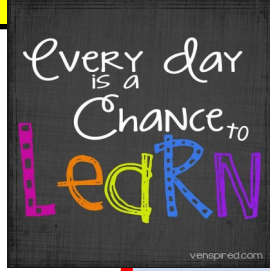

- Learn to play the violin.

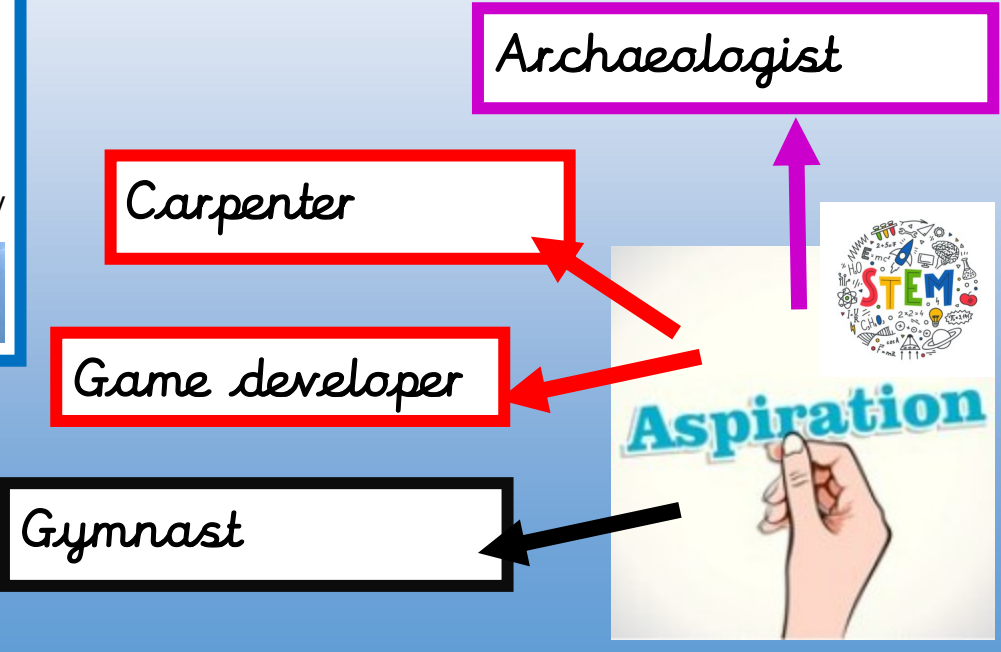
**In History we will:**
