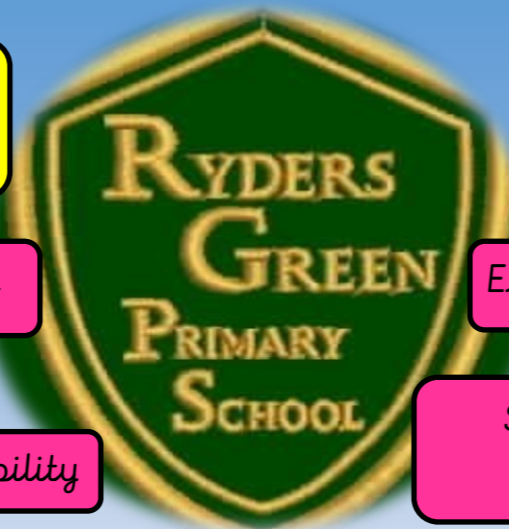

In Reading our focus is..





- In RSHE we will:**

- Learn how to write like Anglo-Saxons and how words we use today date back to Anglo-Saxons.

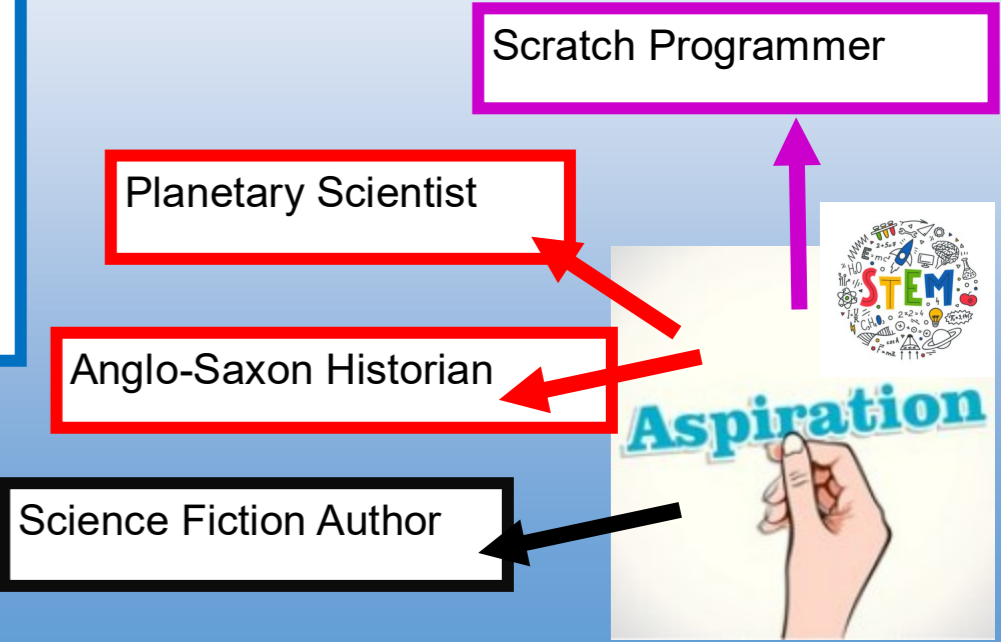
In French we will:
