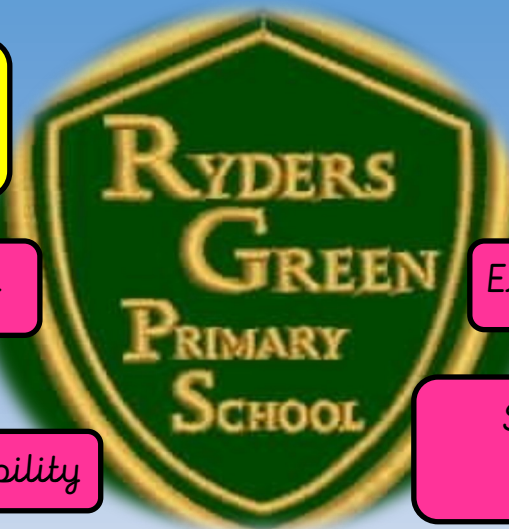

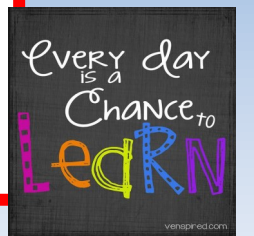

In English our main focus texts will be:

We will also be reading:-

Dipals Diwali, Scarecrows Secret, Stick Man, Gruffalo's Child, and a range of Christmas and winter themed stories.

In phonics we will be focusing on Letters and Sounds phase 1 and will be continuing to develop our listening skills, identifying words that rhyme and beginning to identify the initial sound of an object.

In Reading our focus is..

In R.E. (Understanding of the World) we will:

To learn about different celebrations from different cultures.

In Physical development we will:

- Start taking part in some group activities which they make up for themselves, or in teams.

In the Imagination Studio we will:

- Learn about the Winter season and experience a snowy scene.

Maths:

- Develop fast recognition of sets of objects to 3 without counting.
- Say numbers in order to 5 and above.
- Join in with and explore repeating patterns
- Talk about and explore 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Understand the position of objects through words alone.

In Music (Expressive Arts and Design) we will:

Learning Christmas songs for our fantastic Christmas assembly. We will also listening to the sounds of our musical instruments.

In Geography (Understanding of the World) we will:

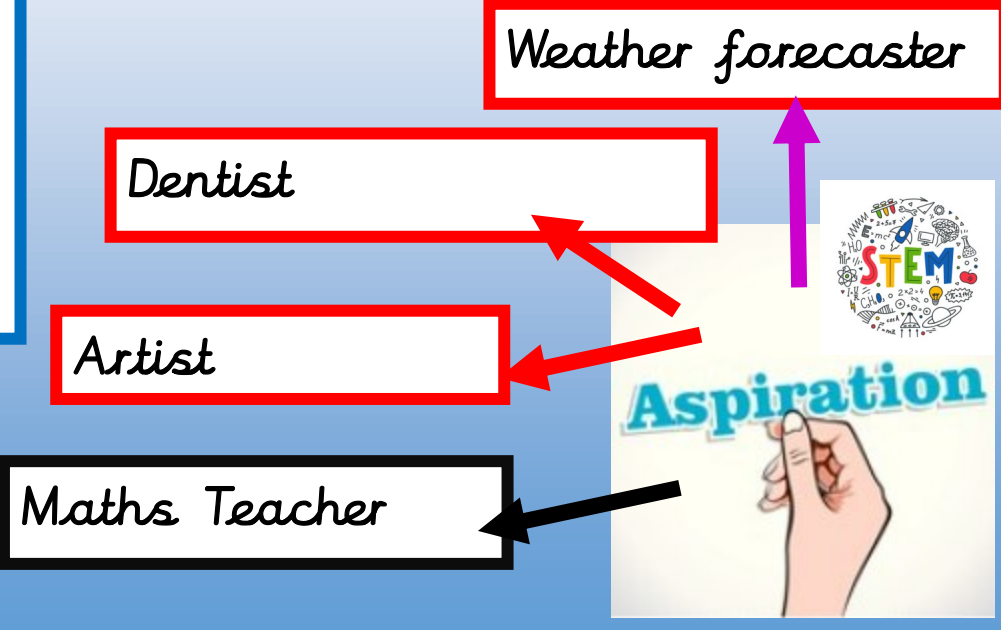
Exploring different locations. This time we are going to explore the forest school every Friday.
