

Ryders Green Primary School Newsletter January 2025

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Are you thinking of taking your child on holiday?

All holidays in term time (now called leave of absence in exceptional circumstances or LOA) must be agreed by the head teacher before the absence is taken.

Parents/carers do not have a right to take their children out of school during term time and may be fined if they do so without the school's authorisation.

Penalty notices, when issued, informs the parents/carers to pay a fine of £80 (if paid within 21 days) or £160 if paid within 28 days (from September 2024).

Penalty Notices are issued separately to EACH individual parent/carer of each individually named child. (i.e. one Penalty Notice per parent per child.

In the case of repeated fines, if a parent receives a second find for the same child within a three-year period, this will be charged at the higher rate of £160.

Fines per parent will be capped to two fines in a three year period. Once this limit has been reached, other action like a parenting order or prosecution will be considered.

If you're prosecuted and attend court because your child hasn't been attending school, you could get a fine of up to £2,500.




The start of February will see Bikeability happening in school for Years 5 and 6. It is an opportunity to develop safe cycling skills.

Our Year 6 pupils have also been invited to watch the dress rehearsal of 'School of Rock' at George Salter Academy.




WORLD BOOK DAY - 6th March 2025

Focus: To continue to improve the writing that we do in our school.

This month, we were very excited to work with some schools in our local area and share tips on ideas of how we all teach writing. Mrs Baron visited another school where she got to look at the writing lessons in Year 1 - Year 6. She will share what she saw with all the teachers and we will see if there are some ideas we can use at our school too!
